Now that the election is done, there is one important question the people of Toronto want to ask — *When are you going to pay your bills?*

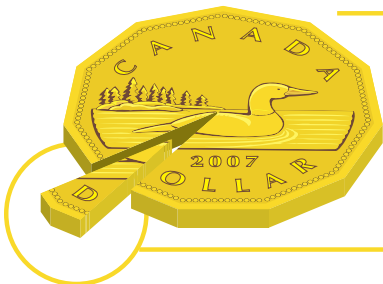
